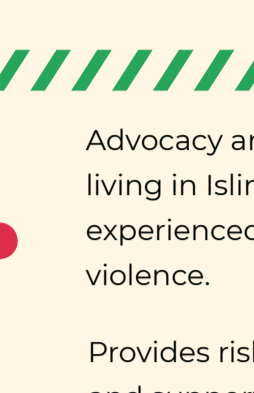

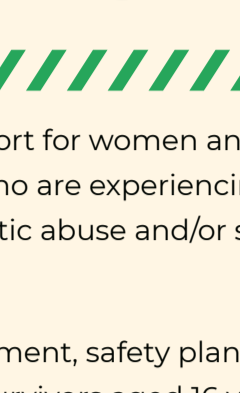

Solace Advocacy and Support Service (SASS)

Advocacy and support for women and men living in Islington who are experiencing/have experienced domestic abuse and/or sexual violence.

Provides risk assessment, safety planning and support to all survivors aged 16 years and over and consultations to professionals.

Support provided by 8 IDVAs (including 5 Targeted IDVAs co-located within housing, health and children's services settings) and 1.5 Caseworkers.

Advocacy and support for Black, Asian, Minority Ethnic and Refugee women living in Islington who are experiencing/have experienced domestic abuse and/or sexual violence including harmful practices.

Provides risk assessment, safety planning and support to all survivors aged 16 years and over.

The Samira Project

Children and Young People's Advocate (CIDVA)

Advocacy and support for children and young people living or attending school in Islington who are or have been in an abusive intimate relationship.

Provides risk assessment, safety planning and support to all survivors under the age of 18 (25 for young people where there is a range of specific needs).

Support provided by 1 IDVA based with the Council's Targeted Youth Support service.

The Domestic Abuse Counselling service provides free, short term therapeutic counselling support to male and female survivors of domestic violence and abuse, improving the self-esteem, confidence and the motivation of service users.

Provides a baseline of 1 assessment session and up to 15 weekly counselling sessions, depending on the needs of the individual taking part.

YUVA - A Child to Parent Violence service

1-2-1 support service working directly with young people age 11-18 (25 for young people where there is a range of specific needs) using violence and abuse.

Parent support service offering 'Who's in charge' 8 week group parenting programme.

Support provided by 0.2 FTE Young People Support Worker based with the Council's Targeted Youth Support and part time staff delivering two parenting groups per annum.

Monthly risk management meeting where professionals share information on high risk cases of domestic abuse and put in place a risk management plan.

Forum for sharing information and drawing up an action plan in order to reduce future harm to high risk survivors and their children.

DA Multi-Agency Risk Assessment Conference (MARAC)

Pause Islington

The service works to prevent the damaging consequences of children being taken into care each year.

Provides 18 months of intensive support to women who have experienced, or are at risk of, repeated pregnancies that result in children needing to be removed from their care.

The service provides case management for residents who are at high risk of domestic abuse.

Works with Islington Council housing tenants to provide crisis intervention, prevent harm and manage risks, empowering residents to maintain and build their resilience and independence focusing on partnership working and integration with other services.

Housing Intensive Tenancy Sustainment

Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) consultation service

The service provides case consultations and support to Children's Social Workers and Family Support Workers.

Works directly with people using intimate partner violence where children and young people are placed at risk due to domestic abuse and where the service user continues to live in the family home or has ongoing to live with the family.

A general-practice based domestic abuse training, support and referral programme for primary care staff.

Provides an opportunity for all Islington GPs, Practice Nurses, HCA's, Practice Managers, and administrative staff to receive free training. IRIS provides a targeted intervention for patients (female/male) aged 16 and above experiencing current or former domestic abuse.

Identification and Referral to Improve Safety (IRIS)

DA and Multiple Disadvantage Housing First Project

Service works with a small case load of five women (at a time) over the age of 18 identified through the DA MARAC where there have been several repeat referrals due to high risk of domestic abuse.

Works with women who have experienced multiple disadvantage including homelessness, mental and physical health problems and substance misuse.

Referrals via Islington DVA MARAC only

Project works with women aged 16+ affected by VAWG who find it difficult to access/engage with support and who are facing severe and multiple disadvantage.

Advocates use assertive outreach techniques and work with women in a trauma-informed way to enable them to access support, increase their self-esteem, reduce their risk and make safe choices.

VAWG Workforce Development

The service works to develop a comprehensive programme of training for practitioners.

Service is available to offer practice support and case consultations for practitioners working with families in Islington affected by domestic abuse.

The refuge accommodation based project provides children and young people with the opportunity to explore their own experiences through delivering 121 focused on safeguarding and group based sessions.

The project works with children and young people who have fled domestic abuse so they are supported, alongside their mothers.

Daily Domestic Abuse Safeguarding Meeting - daily multi-agency risk assessment and safeguarding action planning meeting.

Intimate Partner Violence Panel - multi-agency panel managing intervention and prevention offer to persons using intimate partner violence.

Women's Complex Needs Outreach Worker - working with the women living on the streets, developing, creating solutions and interventions to move them away from the streets into accommodation and support.
